Do you know of college students or faculty who would like to do an internship/fellowship at PNNL? There are several options available, and note that application deadlines are coming up quickly.

#### **Office of Fellowship Programs, <http://ofp.labworks.org>, deadline 2/1/02**

The new Office of Fellowship Programs (OFP) application system replaces the application services previously provided by AWU. The application is available at <http://ofp.labworks.org> and is for college undergraduates, graduate students, and faculty. Details on opportunities for people outside college-level programs can be found at <http://science-ed.pnl.gov/>. The application deadline for the OFP program is 2/1/02 for maximum consideration. The application system will remain open until 4/30/02 for summer appointments, but applying late will decrease the chances of getting an appointment. In a change from the way business was done under AWU, it is now required that any applicant wishing to come to PNNL in Summer 2002 MUST APPLY BY THE 4/30/02 DEADLINE. It will not be possible to make appointments for summer unless the applicant has a complete file in the application pool by 4/30, even if the PNNL host is providing the funding. The OFP system allows applications for Fall and Spring appointments as well.

There are several DOE-sponsored fellowships available for undergraduates, including the Energy Research Undergraduate Laboratory Fellowship (ERULF), Community College Initiative (CCI) and the Pre-Service Teacher (PST) programs. Applications can be found at <http://www.scied.science.doe.gov> and are due 2/1/02 for Summer (no exceptions). The ERULF program also accepts applications for Fall and Spring semesters. These programs are available at DOE sites nationwide, including PNNL.
